


STRAY HEARTS 2022 ANNUAL REPORT

FUNDING, OUTREACH, COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT & IMPACT

- In 2022, Stray Hearts continued to receive core support from local and national funders including Carroll Petrie Foundation, Petco Love, Taos Community Foundation, the Leslie Alexander Foundation, as well as support from individual donors, dedicated volunteer time, estate and planned gifts, and donor-advised funds.
- In 2022, Stray Hearts created several new support programs including Stray Hearts Guardians (monthly donors), Stray Hearts Angels (a planned giving society), a vehicle donation program, a new blog TAILS FROM THE SHELTER, an adoption sponsorship program, and a community events sponsorship program.
- In 2022, Stray Hearts continued to operate its pet food bank, a community resource for disadvantaged Taos residents to receive free dog and cat food for their owned pets.
- In 2022, Stray Hearts continued to receive positive transparency scores from trusted third party non-profit ranking sources Guidestar.org and Charity Navigator.
